Hardware, Software and Internet Requirements for E-Deposit Service

Minimum software and hardware requirements needed for E-Deposit.

- Microsoft Windows XP or Vista (Central Bank recommends having the Automatic Updates feature enabled to help reduce security threats).
- Internet Explorer 6 or later.
- Pentium 4 (or equivalent) processor with at least 512MB RAM.
- Hard drive with a minimum 1 GB free space.
- Super VGA monitor capable of at least 1024x768 resolution.
- One available USB 2.0 compliant port.
- Broadband Internet Connection (DSL, cable or other high speed connection).
- An Anti-virus / Anti-spyware program that is updated daily.

Other Considerations

- During the initial setup, a minimal amount of software is installed including scanner drivers. In order to install this software, the user will need to be logged into the system as an Administrator.
- In the event of website updates or technical difficulty, the bank may attempt to send email alerts to the e-mail address provided by the customer at sign up. In order to be alerted of these events, customers should make sure the address provided is current.

These requirements are posted as of June 25, 2008, and will be updated at least annually. Please check Central Bank's website quarterly for changes or updates to these requirements.
